When you set up your myDMV account you'll get a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to conduct secure transactions at www.dmvNOW.com, without visiting a DMV office.

What can I do online with my DMV PIN?


- ▶ Review my driving record
- ▶ Renew and replace my driver's license or ID card
- ▶ Print my vehicle's original electronic title or replace my title
- ▶ Report that my vehicle was sold or traded
- ▶ Change my address and organ donor status
- ▶ Request a compliance summary revealing steps necessary to reinstate driving privileges
- ▶ Make a reinstatement fee payment
- ▶ Change or activate my PIN

More online transactions

- ▶ Renew vehicle registration, receive discounts, update your record instantly, and receive decals in the mail within five days
- ▶ Order special or personalized license plates
- ▶ Request a new registration card to replace a lost card
- ▶ Make and order souvenir license plates for gifts
